

# STAFF ANALYSIS OF CHANGE WITHOUT REGULATORY EFFECT BSC 01/16

## **SUBJECT:**

Rulemaking file number BSC 01/16 – Change Without Regulatory Effect (CWoRE)

The California Building Standards Commission (BSC) proposes to amend Chapter 16, Section 1613.1.2 from the 2013 California Building Code, (CBC), Part 2 of Title 24, California Code of Regulations (CCR).

## **BACKGROUND:**

The California Building Standards Commission (BSC) is proposing a “change without regulatory effect” to the 2013 California Building Code, Chapter 16, Section 1613.1.2. The amendment clarifies the *earthquake-induced liquefaction* is an additional condition to *landslides* and not inclusive of *landslides* as the current word “of” would indicate. BSC is replacing the incorrect word “of” with the correct word “or” to show that there are three separate conditions related to the mapping areas for fault rupture hazards. This change clarifies the intent of the section and utilizes correct grammar for its application.

## **FINDINGS:**

This proposed action is justified because it meets Section 1613.1.2 Change without Regulatory Effect, criterion 4 of Chapter 1 of the 2013 California Administrative Code, Part 1 of Title 24, to wit:

“4. Revising structure, syntax, cross-reference, grammar or punctuation.”
