

**CBSC STAFF REPORT**  
**BSC 01/14 – Part 3**

**PROPOSING STATE AGENCY:**

California Building Standards Commission (CBSC, BSC)

**APPLICATION AFFECTED:**

State buildings (all occupancies), including buildings constructed by the Trustees of the California State Universities and Colleges and the Regents of the University of California where no state agency has the authority to adopt building standards applicable to such buildings.

**SUBJECT:**

This proposed action would repeal the 2011 edition of the National Electrical Code and adopt the 2014 National Electrical Code by reference with BSC amendments for use as the 2016 California Electrical Code.

**FINDINGS:**

**CBSC Code Advisory Committee (CAC) Comments/Recommendations**

CBSC's Plumbing, Electrical, Mechanical, and Energy CAC (PEME recommended Approve as Submitted. CBSC concurred with CAC recommendations.

**Public Comments received during 45-Day public comment period **October 9-November 23, 2015****

No Public comments were received.

**Staff Findings:**

**CBSC's** Submittal appears to be compliant with the Administrative Procedure Act and Building Standards Law.

**COMMISSION ACTION:**

Staff prepared color Commission Action Matrix's which group the proposed regulations as follows:

- GREEN = Uncontested items
- YELLOW = Challenged items during the public comment period
- SALMON = Withdrawn items by the state agency; no action required.
