OSHPD 06/15 – Part 4

PROPOSING STATE AGENCY:

Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development (OSHPD)

APPLICATION AFFECTED:

General acute-care hospitals and acute psychiatric hospitals, skilled nursing facility, intermediate care facilities, licensed clinic and correctional treatment center construction.

SUBJECT:

This proposed action would repeal the 2013 edition of the Uniform Mechanical Code and adopt the 2015 Uniform Mechanical Code by reference with OSHPD amendments for use as the 2016 California Mechanical Code.
