SFM 01/14 – Part 3

PROPOSING STATE AGENCY:

Office of the State Fire Marshal (SFM)

APPLICATION AFFECTED:

Asylums; jails; hospitals; mental hospitals; homes for the elderly; children's nurseries; children's homes or institutions, schools, or any similar occupancies of any capacity; assembly occupancies for 50 or more persons; motion picture or television production facilities; homes or institutions for the housing of any person of any age for protective social care and supervision.

SUBJECT:

This proposed action would repeal the 2011 edition of the National Electrical Code and adopt the 2014 National Electrical Code by reference with SFM amendments for use as the 2016 California Electrical Code.

FINDINGS:

CBSC Code Advisory Committee (CAC) Comments/Recommendations

SFM's Plumbing Mechanical Electrical and Energy CAC (PEME) recommended Approve as Submitted and Short Term Further Study. SFM concurred with CAC recommendations.

Public Comments received during 45-Day public comment period **October 9-November 23, 2015**

No Public comments were received.

Staff Findings:

SFM's Submittal appears to be compliant with the Administrative Procedure Act and Building Standards Law.

COMMISSION ACTION:

Staff prepared color Commission Action Matrix's which group the proposed regulations as follows:

SALMON = Withdrawn items by the state agency; no action required.
