- 3) **Proposed Code Adoption and Approvals:** The Commission will take action on the following items to approve, disapprove, further study, or approve as amended any of the proposed code changes based on the criteria established in Health and Safety Code 18930. The Commission will consider each agency's proposed changes and its justifications, the Code Advisory Committee (CAC) recommendations, and comments submitted during the public comment periods. The public may comment on any challenges to the proposals or CAC recommendations submitted during the public processes. No new issues or new information challenging the proposed code changes may be presented to the Commission in the adoption of the following proposed regulations.  - a) **Division of the State Architect – Structural Safety (DSA-SS 01/13):** Proposed adoption of amendments to the 2013 California Administrative Code, Part 1, Title 24, California Code of Regulations.
 - b) **Division of the State Architect – Structural Safety (DSA-SS 02/13):** Proposed adoption of amendments to the 2013 California Green Building Standards Code (CALGreen), Part 11, Title 24, California Code of Regulations.
 - c) **California Department of Public Health - (CDPH-CWoRE 01/14):** Proposed Change without Regulatory Effect. Administrative regulations for the CDPH – Articles 1 and 2, Chapter 8, California Administrative Code, Part 1, Title 24, California Code of Regulations affecting public swimming pools and various changes in terms affected by statutory changes.
 - d) **Department of Housing and Community Development - (HCD-CWoRE 02/14):** Proposed Change without Regulatory Effect. Building standards for the HCD – Section A4.107, Appendix A4, California Green Building Standards Code (CALGreen), Part 11, Title 24, California Code of Regulations pertaining to solar photovoltaic (PV) systems streamlined permitting process affected by changes in statute enacted by AB 2188 (Chapter 521, Stats of 2014).
 - e) **Department of Housing and Community Development - (HCD 05/13):** Proposed adoption of amendments to the 2013 California Green Building Standards Code (CALGreen), Part 11, Title 24, California Code of Regulations. Additional 45-day comment period to address item carried over for further study at the July 22, 2014, commission meeting.

****TELECONFERENCE INSTRUCTIONS****

All callers begin in "Listen Only" mode.

When it is time to take comments on a specific agenda item from persons on the phone, callers will hear: *"This conference is now in Question and Answer mode. To alert the speaker that you have a question, press 1 and 0. Each question will be answered in the order it was received."*

If a caller presses 1 and 0, the caller will hear: *"You will be notified when the speaker is ready for your question."*

****Note:** Please refrain from pressing 1 and 0 multiple times. Doing this toggles your position in and out of the call queue. Press 1 and 0 only once and wait for your notification to speak.

When it is your turn to comment you will hear: *"Please ask your question after the tone."* A tone will sound and the caller is now in "Talk" mode.

After each caller has commented, the caller will be placed back into "Listen Only" mode.

When the last caller has commented, the comment period for that item is concluded and the "Question and Answer" mode will be switched back to "Listen Only" mode.
