I live in unincorporated Los Angeles County just outside the northern border of Pasadena. I am very pleased with the new greywater code for the State of California. Not requiring a permit for washing-machine and single-fixture systems is a very important aspect of the code. This provision will make simple greywater systems economical for many Californians seeking to conserve water.

I know I would jump at the chance to install economical greywater recycling systems for the washing machines in all three of the units in the triplex that I own.

The twelve requirements for no-permit systems will protect environmental and public health, while supporting greywater reuse.

Please keep that part of the code intact and continue in this direction of removing barriers to initiating simple, sustainable water-use practices.
