To whom it may concern:

I am writing as a proponent of relaxing gray water restrictions. California has a water crisis - one of 36 states the EPA asserts will experience same in the next ten years ... with normal rainfall. With drought conditions, the number of states in water crisis jumps to 46!!!

In the Sierra Nevada, tree ring science in coordination with sediment studies proves that, over the past 11,000 years, droughts in the region of 30-60 years are not unusual - and droughts 150 years long are not uncommon!!!

Previously used water is the only water source that will GROW.

We need to help more people take advantage of this resource - not make it impossible to implement.
