

**NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES
TO

**REGARDING THE CALIFORNIA BUILDING CODE
CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS, TITLE 24, PART 2
Public Pools**

The California Building Standards Commission (CBSC) on behalf of the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) is providing notice of proposed changes for incorporation into the California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 24, Part 2 which were the subject of written comments from the initial 45-day public comment period that began on May 13, 2011, until June 27, 2011, at 5 PM. CDPH is proposing building standards related to public pools.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

CBSC will accept written comments regarding these proposed changes for at least 45 days between July 19, 2011, until 5:00 PM on September 2, 2011. All written comments must be submitted to CBSC no later than 5:00 PM on September 2, 2011, and addressed to:
