EXPRESS TERMS:

The California Building Standards Commission proposes to amend the 2013 California Plumbing Code (CPC) as follows:

**CHAPTER 4
PLUMBING FIXTURES AND FIXTURE FITTINGS**

...

403.0 Water-Conserving Fixtures and Fittings.

Note: On and after January 1, 2014, certain commercial real property, as defined in Civil Code Section 1101.3, shall have its noncompliant plumbing fixtures replaced with appropriate water-conserving plumbing fixtures under specific circumstances. See Civil Code Section 1101.1 et seq. for definitions, types of commercial real property affected, effective dates, circumstances necessitating replacement of noncompliant plumbing fixtures, and duties and responsibilities for ensuring compliance.

1602.8.2 Commercial, Industrial, and Institutional Occupancies...

1602.8.2.1 Lavatories. *Daily discharge from lavatories may be determined by the following equation:*

Occupants X lavatory flow rate X 3

Equation 16-1

Where:

The number of occupants = square footage of the building divided by the occupant load factor from the California Plumbing Code Chapter 4, Table A.

Lavatory fixture flow rate, new construction = that from the California Green Building Standards (CALGreen) Code ~~Table 5.303.2-3~~ Section 5.303.3.4.1
