Please accept these comments on the HCD's proposed code change [4.106.4.2.1](#):
I am a paraplegic that must use a wheelchair for mobility and I drive my own vehicles and one will be an electric vehicle (disabled accessible van). I have the engineered plans and presently am collecting the necessary parts to build this vehicle. The proposed code changes in your proposal discriminates against people with disabilities because it does not provide the necessary standards that insure that persons with disabilities can use electric vehicle charging stations. Without the requirements for signage, accessible route and van parking loading zone requirements, this proposed code change insures that people with disabilities will be discriminated against in charging station construction.

I will bring suit against any charging station that is not fully accessible to me and my electric accessible van with wheelchair lift . You are in charge of making the charging sites accessible to all voters. So, I am asking that you do your job properly and make all charging stations ADA accessible under current ADA standards
