It appears from the attached that DPH intends to push for adoption during this interim cycle (effective 7/12) as opposed to doing this as a part of the 2013 triennial update (effective 1/14). The Ad Hoc Code Advisory Committee did not actually review the initial DPH proposal and instead suggested DPH move this item into the next triennial update. This recommendation was made based on the enormous size of the proposal and the concerns from various parties that this package needs significant vetting among interested parties. I fully understand that DPH has been working on this package, off and on, for over a decade. However, very few parties were familiar with the package as it stands now. It seems highly probable that significant opposition (local government, pool and spa industry, etc) to this package will emerge at the October 19th BSC Hearing. While CBIA does not have a direct interest in this package, there are generic issues (scope/application and definition) that do need work. Lastly, it would seem prudent to have BF&O and PEME review the new package since a CAC review has yet to take place. After 10 years, I guess I am saying, "What's the rush?" Why not get a focus group together.....identify specific issues that need to be addressed....work on those items and prepare a modified package that local government and industry can get behind?
