

CBSC STAFF REPORT **OSHPD 03/12 – Part 1 & 2**

PROPOSING STATE AGENCY:

Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development (OSHPD)

APPLICATION AFFECTED:

General acute-care hospitals and acute psychiatric hospitals, skilled nursing facility, intermediate care facilities, licensed clinic and correctional treatment center construction.

SUBJECT:

Part 1, California Administrative Code, Chapter 1 and Part 2, California Building Code.

FINDINGS:

CBSC Code Advisory Committee (CAC) Comments/Recommendations

CBSC's Structural Design/Lateral Forces CAC (SD/LF) recommended approve as amended and as submitted. CAC recommended to coordinate sections 1616A.1.5, 1616A.1.13, 1616A.1.29, 2205A.5.1.2, 2206A.2, 3418A.2 and 3418A.4 as Approve as Amended.
