

DGS Helps Purchase and Deliver H1N1 Supplies to California Schools

Through a recently obtained federal grant, Department of General Services coordinated with California Emergency Management Agency (Cal EMA), California Department of Education (CDE) and the Office of Jack O'Connell, State Superintendent of Public Instruction to purchase and deliver millions of emergency H1N1 protective supplies to public and charter schools statewide.

DGS Chief Deputy Director Stephen Amos attended two press conferences together with the California Department of Education and Cal EMA in northern and southern California announcing the multi-agency effort to distribute 15 million masks and 10 million gloves to 58 county offices of education to help prevent the spread of the H1N1 influenza virus and other influenza outbreaks.
