- Has been designed and constructed to the 1976 or later edition of the Uniform Building Code (UBC) and was built after December 19, 1979.
- Is not more than 2,160 square feet in floor area.
- Bears a "commercial coach" insignia of approval from the California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD).
- Is in good structural condition.
- Has its overhead nonstructural elements secured pursuant to Division of the State Architect (DSA) standards.
- Has been placed on a foundation plan approved by a California-registered engineer which meets the 1997 Uniform Building Code standards, or has been placed on a Division of the State Architect (DSA) approved foundation plan.

Access Compliance Certification Requirements

The HCD building(s) indicated above substantially comply with the access compliance requirements for existing buildings as shown in California Building Code (Title 24).

Fire & Life Safety Certification Requirements

- The HCD building(s) have been placed on site in compliance with California Building Code (Title 24), Chapter 5, Part 2, and fire apparatus access roads and gates are provided in accordance with Title 19 of the California Code of Regulations, Sections 3.05 and 3.16.
- Each HCD building is equipped with an evacuation fire alarm consisting of an approved manual pull-station and audible device(s).
