

Solar Photovoltaic (PV) Projects

- 3 projects completed and online, generating approximately 2 MW. The remaining 4 projects will be online January 2007, generating approximately 1.1 MW. In total, all 7 projects will produce of 3.1 MW.
- This electricity is offsetting a portion of power normally purchased from the grid
- This clean, green energy not only reduces pollution, but also reduces the cost of energy to the state, and, ultimately, the taxpayers
- 3.1 megawatts of electricity equates to about the same amount of power consumed by approximately --- homes a year (EXPECTING CONFIRMATION OF TOTALS 7/12)
- 3.1 megawatts of clean generation offsets 1,800 tons of greenhouse gasses a year.
- Current plans call for a second RFP to be issued by September 2006 and construction commencing prior to December 31, 2006. The target for this phase is 5 MW of solar generation.
