ORDER TO LODGE DOCUMENTS

On February 20, 2009, Student filed a motion for stay put. The Los Angeles Unified School District (District) filed no opposition.

Student's motion for stay put did not include a reference to or a copy of Student's last agreed-upon and implemented Individualized Education Plan (IEP). In order for the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) to make a determination of stay put, Student must lodge (meaning, the Student must send to OAH) a copy of the last agreed-upon and implemented IEP.
