ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE
OPPOSITION TO MOTION TO DISMISS

On September 20, 2010, the Paso Robles Joint Unified School District (District) filed a motion to dismiss issues two and three of the amended due process request filed by Student's parents on behalf of Student (Student). On September 22, 2010, Student filed a request for an extension of time to file an opposition to that motion. In the request, Student's educational advocate explained that he has been in hearing and unable to respond to the motion. He requested an extension of time to respond until Friday, September 24, 2010.

Good cause exists to grant the motion. However, the Office of Administrative Hearings will be closed on September 24, 2010, due to the mandatory state work furlough. Therefore, the extension of time will be granted until noon on Monday, September 27, 2010.

The request for an extension of time to file an opposition to the motion to dismiss is granted. Any opposition shall be filed by noon on September 27, 2010.
