ORDER GRANTING FURTHER  
REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL TIME  
TO BREIF MOTIONS

On February 4, 2011, the parties filed a joint stipulation requesting an extension of time, to the close of business on Friday, February 11, 2011, for Student to file responses to the following pending motions:

- 1) Request to Amend Complaint and Alternative Motion to Hear Issue # 1 Prior to Consolidated Issues, filed by the District and Placer County Office of Education (PCOE);
- 2) Motion for Reconsideration of Order Dismissing District's Issue No. 1 and Order Granting Consolidation Due to Change of Circumstances, filed by the District and PCOE;
- 3) Motion in Limine to Exclude Evidence and Testimony Barred by the Statute of Limitations, filed by the District and PCOE; and
- 4) Motion for Reconsideration of Motion to Dismiss Issues Barred by the Statute of Limitations, or In the Alternative Motion for Threshold Hearing Regarding the Statute of Limitations Issue, filed by Placer County Children's System of Care.

On February 7, 2011, the parties' request was granted in part, and Student was given to noon on Thursday, February 10, 2011, to file responses to the four motions described above. At the time, the due process hearing was scheduled to begin on February 14, 2011.

Later on February 7, 2011, at a prehearing conference (PHC), the parties' joint request for a continuance of the PHC and the due process hearing was granted. The PHC was continued to February 16, 2011, and the hearing was continued to February 28, 2011.

On February 9, 2011, the parties jointly filed a further request to extend Student's time to respond to the four motions described above, on the grounds that the PHC and hearing had been continued, leaving additional time for the consideration of motions, and that the parties were in the final stages of reaching an agreement to settle this matter.

Good cause appearing, Student's time to respond to the four motions described above is extended to the close of business on February 16, 2011. All other dates remain on calendar.
