ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR

PHC/HRG

On March 14, 2011, the parties filed a stipulated request to continue the prehearing conference in the above matter to the first day of hearing. In essence, the parties are also requesting a continuance of the first day of hearing based on the impracticality of conducting the PHC on the first day of hearing. The reason given is that the parties are circulating a settlement agreement for signatures.

A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted for good cause. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3); see also Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1020; Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332.) OAH has reviewed the request for good cause and the request is:

noon on 3/25/11.
Due Process Hearing: 3/29-30/11 at 9:00 AM

It is expected that if a final settlement agreement is executed, Student will file a notice of withdrawal / request for dismissal prior to the PHC.
