ORDER GRANTING STUDENT'S
REQUEST TO AMEND COMPLAINT

On February 4, 2011, Student filed a Due Process Hearing Request (complaint), naming Los Angeles Unified School District (District) as respondent. On February 14, 2011, Student filed a Request to Amend the Due Process Hearing Request (amended complaint), naming District, Los Angeles County Office of Education (LACOE), and Opportunities Unlimited Charter High School (OUCHS) as respondents. The respondents filed no opposition.

An amended complaint may be filed when either (a) the other party consents in writing and is given the opportunity to resolve the complaint through a resolution session, or (b) the hearing officer grants permission, provided the hearing officer may grant such permission at any time more than five (5) days prior to the due process hearing. (20 U.S.C. §1415(c)(2)(E)(i).) The filing of an amended complaint restarts the applicable timelines for the due process hearing. (20 U.S.C. §1415(c)(2)(E)(ii).)

The motion to amend is timely and is granted. The amended complaint shall be deemed filed on the date of this order. All applicable timelines shall be reset as of the date of this order. OAH will issue a scheduling order with the new dates.
