ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE A
TRANSCRIPT OF THE AUDIO
RECORDING OF THE JANUARY 28,
2011 IEP MEETING, EXTENDING
TIME FOR THE FILING OF A
RESPONSE AND CLOSING BRIEFS

Based on multiple requests made on behalf of Student by Steven Berniker, Attorney-at-Law, Student requested an extension of time until June 15, 2011 to file a transcript of the audio recording of the January 28, 2011 IEP meeting. The transcript was ordered to be produced by the close of business on June 6, 2011.¹

Through his many letters (requests), Student demonstrated that he worked diligently to meet the filing deadline, but was unable to do so. Also, Student's account has not been disputed by the Twin Rivers Unified School District (District), and District does not oppose the request.

Therefore, good cause exists to grant the request for extension of time. The request for extension of time to file the transcript of the audio recording of the January 28, 2011 IEP meeting is granted.

At the time of this order, a copy of the transcript of the audio recording of the January 28, 2011 IEP has been received by the Office of Administrative Hearings. Therefore, because the transcript was file on June 13, 2011, the deadline for District to file its response to the transcript is extended until June 20, 2011.

Further, because of these filing extensions, the deadline for the filing of the closing briefs by both parties is extended until 5:00 p.m. on July 5, 2011.

¹ In Student's requests dated June 1, 6, and 10, 2011, Mr. Berniker advised that Parent was having some difficulties getting the transcription completed and submitted within the timeline ordered, thus the request for extension of time.
