ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR
CONTINUANCE AND SETTING
PHC/HRG

On April 27, 2011, the parties filed a first stipulated continuance request to continue the PHC and hearing to mutually agreed dates in the future. The grounds for the request were that the parties had entered an interim agreement under which District agreed to provide numerous IEEs that could result in settlement of some or all issues.

A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted for good cause. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3); see also Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1020; Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332 .) Generally, continuances of matters are disfavored. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332(c).)

OAH has reviewed the request for good cause and the request is granted. All dates are vacated. Although the requested hearing dates are in October, no continuances have been granted to date and assessments can be time consuming. However, further continuances are not contemplated given the length of this continuance.

Accordingly, this matter will be set as follows:

Telephonic Prehearing Conference – October 10, 2011 at 1:30 p.m.

Due Process Hearing - October 24-27, 2011 at 1:30 p.m. on the first day, 9:30 a.m. thereafter.
