ORDER GRANTING PEREMPTORY
CHALLENGE

On October 11, 2011, Student filed a peremptory challenge seeking to disqualify Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Carla L. Garrett from hearing this case.

A party is entitled to one peremptory challenge (disqualification without cause) to an ALJ assigned to an Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) hearing, if the challenge is made prior to the prehearing conference. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1034, subds. (a), (b) & (c); Gov. Code, § 11425.40, subd. (d).)

Student's peremptory challenge is timely made and is granted pursuant to Government section 11425.40, subdivisions (a) and (d), and California Code of Regulations, title 1, section 1034, subdivision (c). The prehearing conference and hearing are now assigned to ALJ Deborah Myers-Cregar.
