ORDER DISMISSING ACTION

On November 9, 2011, a telephonic hearing was held regarding a November 2, 2011, Order to Show Cause why the matter should not be dismissed for failure to Student to participate in a prehearing conference. David Tollner, attorney at law, appeared on behalf of Student. Jan E. Tomsy, attorney at law, appeared on behalf of the Alameda Unified School District (District). The hearing was not recorded.

The parties confirmed that the matter had settled and that the settlement had been approved by District's governing Board. Student was to file a request for dismissal by close-of-business November 9, 2011. Student has failed to do so.

Because a due process hearing in this matter is scheduled for November 14, 2011, and the matter has been fully settled, the Office of Administrative Hearings hereby vacates all dates and dismisses this matter in its entirety.
