ORDER DENYING MOTION TO
RESCHEDULE PHC

On December 7, 2011, Student's advocate filed a document called "Conflicting dates Dates with Another Case" stating that the PHC in this matter is scheduled for a date that the advocate is in another OAH hearing. The document is interpreted as a motion to reschedule and is denied.

Student's advocate requested the PHC date and time in this case as part of a stipulated continuance, so there are no grounds to reschedule as the conflict was not cause by OAH. More importantly, it is not good cause to continue the PHC. Student's advocate should plan to inform the ALJ conducting the other hearing about the PHC in this matter so that the hearing can be scheduled around it.
