ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO  
RESET TIMELINES

On December 12, 2011, Parent, on behalf of Student, filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) a due process complaint that named the San Diego Unified School District.

On January 11, 2012, the District filed with OAH a motion to reset the timelines in the case based upon lack of service of the due process complaint.

Student has not filed a response to the motion.

ORDER

1. The District's motion to reset procedural timelines is granted.
2. The currently scheduled mediation and hearing dates in the case are vacated.
3. As of the date of this order, OAH shall issue a new Scheduling Order in the matter based upon the time calculations necessary in a student-brought case.
