ORDER GRANTING FIRST REQUEST
FOR CONTINUANCE AND SETTING
MED/PHC/HRG

On February 27, 2012, the parties filed a stipulated first request to continue all dates on the ground that additional assessment by the California School for the Deaf could assist in settlement at mediation.

A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted for good cause. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3); see also Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1020; Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332.) Generally, continuances of matters are disfavored. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332(c).)

OAH has reviewed the request for good cause and the request is granted. All dates are vacated. This matter will be set as follows:

Mediation:	April 24, 2012 at 9:30 AM [NOTE CHANGE: OAH is dark for mandatory training on the date requested. In addition, the parties requested a mediation on a date that pre-dated when they expected to have the assessment completed.]
Prehearing Conference:	May 2, 2012 at 1:30 PM [NO PHC's on Tuesday, as requested.]
Due Process Hearing:	May 8-10, 2012 at 9:00 AM
