PARENT ON BEHALF OF STUDENT.	ORDER GRANTING/DENYING REQUEST FOR CONTINUANCE AND SETTING MED/TSC/PHC/HRG

On February 16, 2012, District filed a request for a continuance of the PHC and hearing dates to dates that Student is unavailable, and OAH is dark for mandatory training. On February 21, 2012, Student filed a response, stating that Student was not opposed to a continuance, but proposing different dates.

A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted for good cause. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3).) In ruling upon a motion for continuance, OAH is guided by the provisions found within the Administrative Procedure Act and the California Rules of Court that concern motions to continue. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1020; Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332 .) Generally, continuances of matters are disfavored. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332(c).)

OAH has reviewed the request for good cause and the request is granted. All dates except the mediation date are vacated. The parties have agreed to the mediation date, however, OAH is dark and not scheduling PHC's or hearings the week of April 16-20, 2012. Accordingly, the request will be granted to dates OAH is available. This matter will be set as follows:

Mediation: March 13, 2012 at 9:30 AM
Prehearing Conference: April 11, 2012 at 10:00 AM
Due Process Hearing: April 23-26, 2012 at 1:30 PM first day, 9:00 AM
after.
