ORDER REQUIRING FURTHER
SERVICE OF COMPLAINT

On March 16, 2012, Student filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) a complaint herein (Case 2) against the Department of Education (CDE), and served the complaint on CDE.

There is pending another matter brought by Student, *Student v. Plumas Unified School Dist., et al.*, OAH Case No. 2011120543 (Case 1). Student's Second Amended Complaint in Case 1 names the Plumas Unified School District (District), the Plumas County Office of Education (PCOE), and the Plumas Special Education Local Plan Area (SELPA). On March 21, 2012, Student moved in Case 1 to add CDE as a party, or in the alternative, to consolidate Case 1 with Case 2. However, Student has not served the complaint in Case 2 on the parties in Case 1, making them unable to respond to his motions.

ORDER

1. Student shall promptly serve the complaint in this matter (Case 2) on the other parties in Case 1 (the District, PCOE, and the SELPA), and file with OAH a proof of service showing that he has done so.

2. The District, PCOE, and the SELPA shall have to and including 3 business days after receipt of the complaint in this matter (Case 2) to respond to the motions filed on March 21, 2012 by Student in Case 1. Any response to those motions shall state the date on which the agency received the complaint.
