On January 7, 2013, Student filed a timely peremptory challenge to disqualify Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Stella Owens-Murrell from hearing this case.

A party is entitled to one peremptory challenge (disqualification without cause) to an ALJ assigned to an Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) hearing. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1034, subds. (a) & (b); Gov. Code, § 11425.40, subd. (d).) Any challenge to the assigned ALJ shall be made no later than commencement of the prehearing conference. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1034, subd. (c).) Student's peremptory challenge is timely made and is granted pursuant to Government section 11425.40, subdivisions (a) and (d), and California Code of Regulations, title 1, section 1034, subdivision (c). The ALJ assigned to the PHC and hearing is now ALJ Alexa Hohensee.
