ORDER DEEMING AMENDED
COMPLAINT FILED

On June 12, 2012, Student filed an opposition to District's motion to dismiss in which he sought leave to amend his request for due process (complaint) filed on May 31, 2012. On June 13, 2012, District filed a response in which it did not oppose Student's motion to amend. On June 20, 2012, Student filed a formal motion to amend along with a proposed amended complaint. District did not oppose the motion to amend.

On June 22, 2012, the Office of Administrative Hearings issued an order granting District's motion to dismiss Issue 1, and granting Student leave to amend. The order specified that upon the filing of Student's amended complaint, timelines would start over. Student's proposed amended complaint is deemed filed on June 25, 2012, the next business day subsequent to the order of June 22, 2012. All timelines start over as of this date, and OAH shall issue a new scheduling order.
