ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR  
EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE  
AMENDED COMPLAINT

On February 12, 2013, the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) issued an order of determination of sufficiency of due process complaint in this matter. In that order, Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Peter Paul Castillo found that all of the issues in Student's complaint were sufficiently pled, with the exception of issues 1 and 3a. ALJ Castillo's order permitted Student to file an amended complaint not later than February 26, 2013.

On February 26, 2013, Student filed a joint stipulation to extend time to file an amended complaint signed by counsel for both parties. The parties asked for an extension of time to allow the parties to participate in mediation prior to incurring the costs of amending the complaint.

As both parties are in agreement regarding the extension, the request for extension of to file the amended complaint is granted. Student has until March 8, 2013, to file an amended complaint in compliance with OAH's order dated February 12, 2013.
