AMENDED ORDER GRANTING  
REQUEST FOR CONTINUANCE AND

On July 12, 2013, Student, through counsel, submitted a letter to the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH), informing that the parties had reached a settlement in the case subject to the holding of an IEP meeting on or before July 19, 2013. The letter requested that OAH set a Status Conference; however, OAH will treat the request as one for a continuance to ensure that the matter reaches a final resolution.

A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted for good cause. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a) & (c) (2006); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3); Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1020.) OAH has reviewed the request for good cause and considered all relevant facts and circumstances. The request is: Granted. All dates are vacated. This matter will be set as follows:
