OAH has reviewed the request for good cause and considered all relevant facts and circumstances. The request is: Granted. All dates are vacated. This matter will be set as follows:

Prehearing Conference:	12/02/2013, at 1:00 p.m.
Due Process Hearing:	12/10/2013; 12/11/2013, and continuing day to day, Monday through Thursday, as needed at the discretion of the Administrative Law Judge.
