ORDER GRANTING DISTRICT'S
MOTION TO STRIKE AMENDED
APPENDIX B TO STUDENT'S
CLOSING BRIEF

On November 12, 2014, Student filed an "Amended Appendix B" to Student's closing brief. On November 12, 2014, Downey Unified School District filed a motion to strike Amended Appendix B. On November 17, 2014, Student filed a response opposing District's motion.

On the last day of hearing in this matter, October 20, 2014, the hearing was continued to November 10, 2014 for the parties to file closing briefs. This order gave the parties three full weeks to prepare their closing arguments.

Student's Amended Appendix B was untimely filed. In addition, Amended Appendix B appears to be an improper attempt to supplement the record with evidence of the cost of Student's privately funded programs, rather than argument to assist the administrative law judge in making findings of fact and conclusions of law.

Accordingly, District's motion to strike is granted.
