ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO  
AMEND COMPLAINT

On September 18, 2015, Student filed a Complaint for Due Process Hearing naming Citizens of the World Charter School. On October 7, 2015, Student filed an Amended Complaint for Due Process Hearing and naming Los Angeles Unified School District (amended complaint). No opposition was received from either Citizens of the World Charter School or Los Angeles Unified School District.

An amended complaint may be filed when either (a) the other party consents in writing and is given the opportunity to resolve the complaint through a resolution session, or (b) the hearing officer grants permission, provided the hearing officer may grant such permission at any time more than five (5) days prior to the due process hearing. (20 U.S.C. §1415(c)(2)(E)(i).) The filing of an amended complaint restarts the applicable timelines for the due process hearing. (20 U.S.C. §1415(c)(2)(E)(ii).)

The motion to amend is timely and is granted. The amended complaint shall be deemed filed on the date of this order. All applicable timelines shall be reset as of the date of this order. OAH will issue a scheduling order with the new dates.
