ORDER CONTINUING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE AND ORDER TO
SHOW CAUSE WHY THE
STUDENT'S COMPLAINT SHOULD
NOT BE DISMISSED

On January 25, 2016, a telephonic prehearing conference was held before Administrative Law Judge Chris Butchko, Office of Administrative Hearings. Robin Faigin, Director of Special Education, Ventura Unified School District, appeared on behalf of District. There was no appearance on behalf of Student, despite three attempts to reach Parent at the contact number listed on Student's due process hearing request. Parent, on behalf of Student, did not attend the mediation session, and did not give notice that Parent would not be participating.

Student is ordered to show cause at a telephonic prehearing conference on Friday, January 29, 2016, at 10:00 a.m., as to why this matter should not be dismissed for failure to participate, prosecute, or advance the matter. Should Student provide adequate justification at the hearing on the order to show cause, the PHC will proceed at that time. Student is further ordered to file a PHC statement by 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 27, 2016. The parties are reminded that each party also must serve on the opposing party, by 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, January 28, 2015, final witness lists and copies of all exhibits to be used at hearing, pursuant to Education Code section 56505, subdivision (e)(7).
