ORDER DENYING REQUEST FOR
CONTINUANCE OF EXPEDITED
PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On May 3, 2016, Student and Salinas Union High School District filed a request to continue the prehearing conference date in this matter with the Office of Administrative Hearings. The two parties indicate that they are close to settlement and want the expedited PHC continued from May 9 to May 11, 2016, to give the parties time to finalize settlement. There was no signature or any correspondence from County of Monterey Health Department or any indication the request was served on County of Monterey.

A expedited due process hearing must be conducted 20 school days of receipt of the due process notice. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a) & (c) (2006); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3); Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1020.)

Denied. All hearing dates and timelines shall proceed as calendared. Here, the parties have requested a continuance of the PHC to Wednesday May 11, 2016. OAH does not schedule PHC's on Wednesdays. Further, the parties failed to show that County of Monterey was served with or joined in the request. Therefore, the request is denied.
