RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. A request for undercover license plates must be filed with the Department of Motor Vehicles, at Sacramento, for each individual vehicle, and must be signed personally by the head of the law enforcement or criminal justice agency.
2. The request for undercover license plates along with the application required for registration of the vehicle and any existing plates shall be sent or delivered by the applicant to the **personal attention of the manager of Confidential Records Unit, Sacramento Department of Motor Vehicles.**
3. One request for certification and a list in duplicate of nonexempt vehicles being renewed must be filed annually with the Department of Motor Vehicles and each certification shall be valid for one year. **The Department will not notify the agency prior to expiration of the nonexempt registration.**
4. Each request filed shall include a certification under penalty of perjury that the vehicle assigned "...to persons responsible for investigating actual or suspected violations of the law or other institution under the jurisdiction of the Department of Corrections by parole or the supervision of persons liberated from an institution under the jurisdiction of the Department of the Youth Authority by parole, and is intended for use in the line of duty." (5001 C.V.C.)
5. If the vehicle being registered with undercover plates has previously been registered with exempt plates, the plates and registration card must be surrendered before the undercover plates may be issued.
6. No undercover license plate shall be used on, or attached to, any vehicle other than the vehicle for which they are issued.
7. Whenever a vehicle registered with undercover license plates is to be sold, or otherwise disposed of, or is to be assigned or transferred to duty in the agency to use other than as set forth in the request for such plates, the undercover plated issued for such vehicle **shall be sent or delivered to the personal attention of the manager of Confidential Records Unit, Sacramento Department of Motor Vehicles** with the corresponding registration card. The department will then take the appropriate action as requested when plates and registration card are surrendered.
