TO: ALL SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND COUNTY SUPERINTENDENTS OF SCHOOLS

SUBJECT: RELOCATABLE CLASSROOMS AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE

The State of California, through the Office of Public School Construction, is liquidating its inventory of relocatable classrooms as part of the Phase Out Plan adopted by the State Allocation Board (SAB) on October 26, 2005. School districts and charter schools currently have priority when purchasing these classrooms. Beginning August 15, 2009, the remaining relocatable classrooms will be offered to public entities pursuant to the SAB Phase Out Plan. School districts and charter schools will still be able to purchase these classrooms after that date on a first-come-first-served basis.

The current inventory of relocatable classrooms can be a viable alternative to modernizing or building new classrooms for school districts and charter schools during these economic times. Each relocatable classroom provides 960 square feet of classroom or storage space. The buildings, due to various ages, range in price from \$4,000 to \$12,000, plus relocation expenses, which are the responsibility of the buyer.
