NOTICE OF MODIFICATIONS TO THE TEXT OF REGULATIONS

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code Section 11346.8(c) and Section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the State Allocation Board is providing notice of changes made to Regulation Sections 1859.2, 1859.71.6 and 1859.77.4 of Title 2, California Code of Regulations relating to the Leroy F. Greene School Facilities Act of 1998. These changes are sufficiently related to the regulatory text and provide the rating criteria for High Performance Incentive Grants, which permit funding for designs and materials that promote energy and water efficiency, natural lighting, improved indoor air quality, recycled materials and substances with minimal toxins, and acoustics that aid in teaching and learning. These changes were unanimously adopted by the State Allocation Board on August 22, 2007; no comments were received during the initial 45-day public comment period, which ended on March 12, 2007.

If you have any comments regarding the proposed changes, the Board will accept written comments between August 27, 2007 and September 12, 2007. All written comments must be submitted to the Board no later than 5:00 p.m. on September 12, 2007, and addressed to:
