State Allocation Board Meeting, May 21, 1997

IMPLEMENTATION POLICY FOR JOINT-USE PROJECTS

PURPOSE OF REPORT

To present a policy for approval of projects requesting Joint-Use funding.

DESCRIPTION

On April 2, 1997, the State Allocation Board (SAB) set aside \$25 million for projects that include funding for joint-use of facilities pursuant to Education Code Sections 17750 or 17751. The SAB directed that a proposed policy for implementation of this program be developed and presented for SAB consideration at this meeting.

The Office of Public School Construction and the SAB Implementation Committee have developed and agree to the proposed policy as shown on the attachment.

RECOMMENDATION

Approve the Joint-Use policy as shown on the attachment.

BOARD ACTION

In considering this Item, the Board approved the OPSC's recommendation with the exception of the following sections referred to in the attached policy:

"APPORTIONMENTS AND RELEASE OF FUNDS" - The Board directed the OPSC to review this section and assure that the final apportionment be based on the final cost (result of bids) and that the funds be released accordingly.

"FUNDING PRIORITY" - The Board directed the OPSC to assure that the priority for funding be based on the submittal of the completed application package, not on letter requests. The Board informed the OPSC to administer this program in a similar fashion as the 60/40 Program; on a first come, first served basis and based on eligibility and specific receipt date for acceptance of the applications.

The OPSC and the SAB Implementation Committee are to address these two issues in addition to the possible funding expansion for Joint-Use projects that include facilities beyond libraries, gymnasiums, and multi-purpose facilities.
