



ASSEMBLY BILL 127 WORKSHOPS



HIGH PERFORMANCE INCENTIVE GRANT AND SEISMIC MITIGATION

The Office of Public School Construction (OPSC) and the Division of the State Architect will be conducting informational workshops at various locations throughout California to provide interested parties helpful information regarding funding opportunities provided by Proposition 1D and changes to the School Facilities Program (SFP) as a result of the passage of Assembly Bill 127. The workshops will review two recently approved programs:

High Performance Incentive Grant

The SFP regulations for the High Performance Incentive Grant Program became effective October 1, 2007, and provide \$100 million in incentive grants to promote the use of high performance attributes in new construction and modernization projects for K-12 schools. High performance attributes include using designs and materials that promote energy and water efficiency, maximize the use of natural lighting, improve indoor air quality, utilize recycled materials and materials that emit a minimum of toxic substances, and employ acoustics that are conducive to teaching and learning.

Seismic Mitigation

Proposition 1D authorized up to \$199.5 million for seismic mitigation of school facilities that are the most vulnerable of Category 2 buildings and pose an unacceptable risk of injury during a seismic event. In order to accommodate this funding, Assembly Bill 127 provided amendments to Education Code Section 17075.10 and the Facility Hardship Program. The State Allocation Board approved regulations at the September 26, 2007 meeting and the OPSC has begun the process to obtain approval from the Office of Administrative Law.
