### **Federal Renovation Program**

The United States Department of Education has set aside approximately \$103 million for the renovation of schools in California. These funds will be made available through the Federal Renovation Program. Qualifying Public School Districts, County Superintendent of Schools, Charter Schools, and Non-Profit Private Schools are encouraged to apply for these funds.

The regulations to implement this new program were adopted by the State Allocation Board at the January 23, 2002 meeting. The Office of Public School Construction will be conducting outreach presentations at various locations throughout the State. You are invited to attend at the location near you.
