<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Adjustments to the Automatic Fire Detection/Alarm and Automatic Sprinkler Requirement</u></p> <p>Provides grant adjustments to purchase and install automated fire detection, alarm and sprinkler systems required by Senate Bill 575.</p>	Proposed regulations pending an exception and departmental approval.	1859.71.2 and 1859.78.4
