**APPLICATION FILING PERIOD:**

**July 1, 2009 – September 28, 2009**

At the May State Allocation Board \$50.9 million in Proposition 1D and Proposition 47 funds was made available for the new construction of charter schools and the rehabilitation of existing district owned facilities for charter school purposes. This program allows charter schools that provide site based instruction to access State facility funding directly or through the school district where the charter school is physically located and to acquire a preliminary apportionment and advanced funding.

The Office of Public School Construction (OPSC), the California School Finance Authority, and the California Department of Education will be conducting presentations to provide an overview of the Charter School Facility Program and the application process at various locations throughout the State. Both charter school and school district facility personnel may benefit from the presentation. For the second half of the workshop, we will be conducting one-on-one sessions with interested parties to walk through every step of the application process, including how to complete the *Application for Charter School Preliminary Apportionment* (Form SAB 50-09).
