

# Charter School Facility Workshops

**APPLICATION FILING PERIOD:**

**APRIL 1 – JULY 29, 2004**

Assembly Bill 14 created the Charter School Facility Program (CSFP) and Proposition 55 provided \$300,000,000 in funding for the new construction of facilities for charter schools. This program allows charter schools that provide site based instruction to access State facility funding directly or through the school district where the charter school is physically located and to acquire a preliminary apportionment.

The Office of Public School Construction (OPSC), the California School Finance Authority, the California Department of Education, the Division of the State Architect, and the Department of Toxic Substance Control will be conducting presentations to provide an overview of the Charter School Facility Program and the application process at various locations throughout the State. Both charter school and school district facility personnel may benefit from the presentation. Recently Senate Bill 15 modified the CSFP, so those who attended the workshops in 2003 may also wish to attend this year to learn about the changes that have been implemented.

Please be aware that one qualification for accessing funding is that the school district where the charter school will be located must have new construction eligibility. Current eligibility for school districts can be found at <http://www.opsc.dgs.ca.gov> under "What's New".
