Why do elementary and middle school projects need CTEAC letters/minutes? Career Tech projects only apply to high school projects.	Education Code Section 17070.955 requires that career technical education advisory committees provide written confirmation that the need for vocational and career technical facilities for the district is being adequately met for any application for funding for any construction or modernization project. The letter or meeting minutes are not to certify that the CTE facilities for the specific site are adequate, but instead to certify that there are adequate CTE facilities district wide.
