

ADDITIONAL DELIVERY REQUIREMENTS:

Requested deliveries to job sites outside regular working hours shall incur an additional charge for delivery of \$3.50 per ton "portal to portal".

Requested deliveries to job sites outside the regular working hours and or days may require plant opening. Additional charge for delivery shall be \$3.50 per ton. Plus \$1,500.00 for plant opening.

NOTE: UNPLANNED DELAYS WILL BE PAID AT THE STANDING TIME CHARGE OF \$1.25 PER MINUTE.

MINIMUM ORDER:

Minimum orders shall be 20 tons per day with a maximum of 500 tons per day.

CERTIFICATIONS:

Contractor is required to assure that all materials furnished from California mines comply with the Surface Mining and Reclamation Act of 1975 (Sand, Gravel, Aggregates and other Minerals) are from a source listed by the Department of Conservation or is in a class that is not subject to these requirements.

For example, the Contractor/Supplier will be required to furnish a proposed Gradation Letter along with samples of Aggregate, Asphalt Binder, and all Additives proposed for use in each mixture to be supplied from this contract.

All material and data submitted to the Region/District Engineer shall conform to Sections 39-2.02 "Aggregates," and 39-1.01 "General," of the current issue of the Department of Transportation, Standard Specification.

PRIMARY DELIVERY COST:

Primary requirements: ½" Aggregate, AR4000 Binder, Transfer End Dump Deliveries
