**RE: Iran Contracting Act Implementation**

---

The California Department of General Services (DGS) has released the Iran Contracting Act of 2010 (ICA) list, which identifies companies that are currently prohibited from doing business with state agencies, public universities, colleges and schools, as well as local governments. Publication of the ICA list, which includes 63 companies identified by DGS that are providing goods or services of \$20 million or more to the energy sector of Iran, was mandated by legislation (AB 1650) signed last year. The Iran Contracting Act of 2010 list is available online [here](#). The list is a constantly changing document that must be reviewed regularly.
